The Big Muddy Dance Company, a St. Louis contemporary jazz dance company, seeks to build a love of dance by providing fun, experiential, and highly entertaining performances while training and developing talent for the future. By engaging emerging and renowned choreographers, we continue to intrigue audiences. We aim to invigorate life through dance by collaborating across the community through outreach.

Dance Concert Productions: The Big Muddy Dance Company produces three full concert runs (4-6 shows) per year, presenting new choreographic works to diverse audiences across the St. Louis area. These audiences range from 300-650 people per performance. Productions are also booked by outside presenters and the company is commissioned to perform both in St. Louis and out of town.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 51,914.52 including grants of \$ 0) (Revenue \$ 51,259.37)

Dance Education & Specialized Training: intense training and classes for high school age and up students, with opportunities for choreography and performance through the Convergence Trainee Program. The students develop 2 studio showcases per year and present newly learned and rehearsed choreographic works. Additionally, aspiring dance students ages 13 & up may participate in the company's summer dance intensive, involving 4 weeks of technique classes, choreography, mental training, muscle awareness, and injury prevention.

Senior Citizen outreach program: The Big Muddy Dance Company visits over 25 retirement facilities and nursing homes throughout the St. Louis area and beyond to perform professional quality dance to those who are often unable to access such in theaters. The program, entitled "Senior Embrace," has grown tremendously and now includes the development of a hands-on workshop for Alzheimer's and dementia patients to strengthen the mind-to-muscle connection through movement.
